

Basis For Recognition:

Risk Communication Excellence Award

The basis for recognition should include such things as: what was the objective; over what time period did the communication take place; did the communication reach a large audience; did the communication directly involve the public; how effective was the communication; were multiple organizations involved; was the communication in support of the Alliance mission.

Risk Reduction Achievement Award

The basis for recognition should include such things as: distinctions that made the risk reduction creative/innovative/unique; attempt to quantify the risk reduction as a percentage, probability or other measurement descriptor; what were the resources required to complete the task such as money, people, time, technology; within what time period did the project take place and what is its current status.

Second Mile Award

The basis for recognition should include such things as: how much of the task(s) was part of the person's normal job duties; how much did the effort support the ACS mission; what was the impact of the effort.
